- I. Call to Order
  - Vice-President, Scott Frush, called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.
- II. Approval of Agenda
  - The agenda was APPROVED as presented.
- III. Approval of Meeting Minutes of May 19, 2016

- IV. <u>Library Director's Report</u> Julie Herrin
  - A. Statistics
    - o Circulation and Door Count are up from last year.
    - o Database use and computer use are down.
    - WiFi and Meeting Room use are steady.
  - B. Summer Reading begins June 17th.
    - o Theme is "On Your Mark, Get Set, Read".
    - o Very grateful for Friends help for registration.
    - o Youth/Teen program is the same as last year.
    - o Adult change in prizes: 1 and 2 small gifts, 3 coffee cards, grand prize is \$50 gift certificate to Next Chapter.

    - o Patricia Garavagiolia is retiring June 24th.
    - Lynne Hirschelman is also retiring on August 26th after 27 years.

o Hiring Maureen Simari who has worked in Novi and at Schoolcraft Community College.

# E. Library Board of Trustees Election

- o Anyone wishing to run for Trustee position must file a petition by July 21. Forty (40) signatures must be on separate petition forms for Northville, Northville Township, and Oakland Co. In lieu of signatures, a candidate may pay \$100 to Wayne County.

# VIII. <u>Committee Reports</u>

- A. Used Book Sales read by Scott Frush for Carol Oldenburg
  - o Vendor sales were down slightly from the previous month.
  - o Cart and Cellar sales were strong for the month.
  - o Total sales were \$2,318.84, 7% increase from last month, and 30% over the same month last year.

# B. Membership - Regina Mingela

- Seventy-four (74) second request/reminders to renew have been sent out. Twenty-four (24) have been received in response.
- $\circ$  Other sources of memberships this month are: store 1, Program 1, other 1.
- o Total memberships are 204.

#### C. Gift Store - Linda Schwelnus

- o From March 1st to May 31st, the Gift Store had an income of \$4,020.39, and expenses of \$3,059.06.
- $\circ$  The Friends Gift Store will participate in Sidewalk Sales, July 29th and 30th.

# G. Public Relations - Chris Litka

- $\circ$  The Library 20th Anniversary Celebration is October 16th from 2-4:30 P.M.
- Prizes the library will supply several small prizes. It was suggested that an IPad be the Grand Prize that Friends would donate. Discussion followed with concerns expressed.
   Suggestion to the Planning Committee was made and voted on that Friends donate a \$500 gift certificate (VISA).
- Volunteers will work from 2-4:30 P.M. Regina Mingela, JoAnnKissel, Judy DeFrancesco, Linda Schwelnus, and Deborah Stanifer volunteered.
- A visual timeline (going back to the 1800"s) will be created for the Library. It was suggested that a similar visual timeline be created about the Friends.

- o Jim Morche urged the Friends to display their list of the more than \$600,000 in gifts to the Library in the Friends alcove.
