

2019 Friends of NDL Local Scholarships

The Friends of the Northville District Library are pleased to announce three \$500 scholarship opportunities for students that volunteer within our organization.

High school seniors who have volunteered with the Friends of the Northville District Library as a junior or senior, will graduate from public, private or home school in June 2019 and will continue their education as a full-time student in a college, university or trade school in fall 2019 are eligible.

Application process:

If you attend Northville High School, applications are part of NHS local scholarship packets. You must submit all required documentation through the NHS local scholarship process with the counseling office.

If you attend a private school or are home schooled, applications will be available on the NDL website under the Friends tab. You must submit all required application documentation to drstacer@dsemail.com

****Applications must be submitted by March 5, 2019. NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED****

Three \$500 scholarships awarded.

Scholarship requirements: To qualify for the scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a high school senior with a 3.0 GPA or higher
- Attend Northville High School OR be a Northville resident attending a private school OR be a Northville resident that is home schooled
- Have volunteered for Friends of the Northville District Library event as a junior or senior (volunteer opportunities available – drstacer@dsemail.com)
- Submit all required application documentation by the date specified by Northville High School if your attend Northville High School OR submit all required application documentation to drstacer@dsemail.com if you attend a private school or are home schooled
- Be enrolled in a college/university or trade school for fall 2019
- Be available to attend NDL Friends Board meeting in May

Selection considerations:

-350 word personal essay - *how libraries have helped me to achieve my academic goals and influenced or had an impact on my personal life* (highest weight in award decision)

- Academic and leadership achievement – transcript and list of leadership roles in high school required
- Volunteer participation for the Friends of the Northville District Library either as a junior or senior (email drstacer@dsemail.com for volunteer opportunities)
