Due to continuing spread of the COVID-19 (Novel coronavirus) in Michigan, especially in Oakland and Wayne Counties, the Northville District Library has made the difficult decision to close its facility to the public on March 15th until further notice.

The health and safety of the residents of our community as well as our loyal and dedicated staff are at the forefront of our decision-making process.

The Northville District Library will continue to monitor and follow guidance from the Oakland and Wayne County Health Departments, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

The Northville District Library will work to resume normal operations as soon as conditions in the community allow for it. We will work to provide you with service updates.

The Northville District Library has an outdoor-drop box near its entrance. It encourages patrons to continue to use this mechanism to return materials. All overdue fines that would be assessed during this closure will be waived.
