Dear Northville District Library Patrons:

Due to the continuing spread of the COVID-19 (Novel coronavirus) in Michigan, the Northville District Library has made the difficult decision to close its facility to the public on March 15th until further notice. The health and safety of the public are at the forefront of our decision-making process.

The Northville District Library will continue to monitor and follow the directives and recommendations from the Oakland and Wayne County Health Departments, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

The Northville District Library will work to resume normal operations as soon as conditions in the community allow for it. We will work to provide you with service updates.

If you have library materials in your possession, we ask that you do not return them during this closure period. The outside book returns have now been closed. ***Please be assured that all overdue fines incurred during this closure will be waived.***

The Northville District Library also will not be able to accept donations of used books.

In the meantime, the Northville District Library provides access to hundreds of e-books, magazines, newspapers, audiobooks, that you can use from the comfort of your own home or office.
