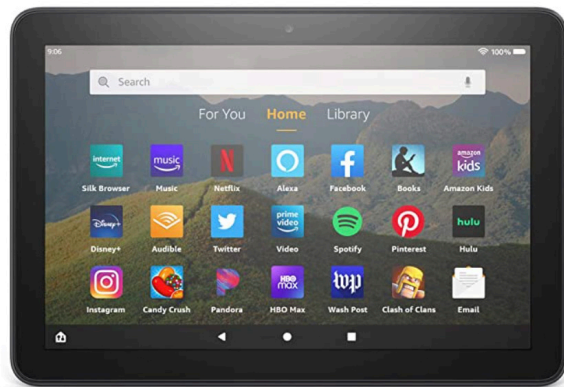


HOW TO INSTALL THE LIBBY APP ON YOUR KINDLE FIRE TABLET

Downloading the Libby App:

The Libby app is not available in the Amazon app store on Kindle Fire devices. Please follow the directions below to install the Libby app.



1. PREPARE YOUR FIRE TABLET

Go to **Settings > Security (or Applications) > Enable Apps from Unknown Sources** (this will prompt a warning message—that’s normal).

2. OPEN YOUR BROWSER

Visit <https://apps.goodereader.com/android-apps/e-readerapps/?did=39495> where you’ll find the Libby app. It will be called Overdrive Libby. Tap on the **Download** button.



3. INSTALL THE LIBBY APP

After the download is complete, tap **Open > Install** to install the Libby app.

4. SET UP THE LIBBY APP

Launch the Libby app from the Kindle’s carousel page and follow the prompts to find your library and add your library card(s) to the app.

5. GO BACK TO STEP 1

Disable the setting “Enable Apps from Unknown Sources.”
