Planning for our current library building was a long, and well thought out process, which began in early 1994 and involved a dedicated team comprised of library staff members, Trustees, and representatives from the city and the township. Janine Bauchat who was President of the Friends at the time, was also part of that team. Janine recalls that from the beginning, the little space at the front of the building, next to the entrance was intended to be the Friends Gift Store, and she was instrumental in making that happen. Janine remembers that her first sale in the new store in October of 1996 was a Friends sweatshirt!

From the beginning, the store was seen as another way for the community to connect with the library as well as a way for the Friends to raise funds which would be donated to the library for programming and equipment. Another volunteer who shared Janine's passion for this project was Amy Storm, who enthusiastically served as the manager, treasurer, volunteer coordinator, and general cheerleader for many years.

Early merchandise in the store included Friends sweatshirts, T-shirts, and mugs, and soon included items that patrons may have needed while working in the library, such as pens, pencils, index cards, & erasers. Berclay Ruschak, who had previously owned the "Bookstall on Main" in downtown Northville, became the manager and buyer for the Friends Gift Store in the winter of 2000. She expanded the merchandise lines which by then included such things as puppets, jewelry, puzzles and small toys and had a talent for finding unique and different things. Getting everything she bought to fit in that little space was often a challenge! Berclay continued to volunteer as the store buyer for 22 years.

Other volunteers who began in the early 2000s and were instrumental to the long-term success of the store were: Peggy Koppy, Carol Holland, Gillian Serjeant, Barbara Hudgins, Margaret Eminger, Jeanne Storm, and Joan Sellen. As a big fan of libraries, I was excited to find the store after moving to Northville and I began volunteering in 2003. I became the store manager in 2007 and was joined by Linda Schwelnus who became the new store treasurer in 2010. Over the years, there were many wonderful volunteers who quickly found the store to be an enjoyable and interesting place to "work" while socializing with friends and patrons, and contributing to the community. Store volunteers were a solid team, and I am grateful for their dedication to the library and the Friends.

The store continued to be a successful endeavor for the Friends for over 25 years, selling not only merchandise, but also memberships and gift book donations. The store volunteers served as ambassadors for the Friends and often answered questions about the library and the town. In 2022 after much thought and discussion, the decision was made to close the store and make the space available to the library. The Friends mission is to support the library however we can, and we recognize that with changing times come changing expectations from the community. We also know that space is limited at 212 West Cady. We look forward to seeing what plans our creative library staff will have for the "little space at the front".






These Precious Days: Essays by Ann **Patchett**


