## Northville District Library Policy on Citizen Comments to the Library Board of Trustees Meetings

The purpose of this policy is to provide for the orderly conducting of District Library Board of Trustees Meetings while, at the same time, providing adequate opportunity for citizens to offer their opinions and views regarding their library and its programs.

The Northville District Library Board of Trustees shall allow time, immediately following the approval of minutes, for citizen comment regarding items of interest or personal concern to them.

Citizens will be given a maximum of five (5) minutes to express their views during the citizen comment period.

The Chair will have the responsibility to insure that this policy is followed.
