This current iteration of the chorus was formed in 2018 and has already garnered wonderful accolades. They are the 2019 Pioneer District (State of Michigan) Chorus Champions and have also competed against choruses from all over the world in the Barbershop Harmony Society International Chorus Contest where they placed 15th in 2022 and shot up to 9th in 2023.
